

Workshop on Dissection and Discussion on Gender Gaps in Modern India organized by the School of Social Sciences in collaboration with Durga India

The School of Social Sciences, Assam Kaziranga University, Jorhat organized a workshop on 'Gender Sensitization Programme' in collaboration with Durga India on 2nd November, 2021 in the university campus. Durga India is a non-profit organization based in Bangalore that works on various issues related to women and their problems. Their main goal is to make the society aware of the problems and various forms of abuses that women experience on a day to day basis, and effectively address these problems. The sole purpose of creating Durga was to ensure women's safety from everyday instances of harassment. The resource persons for the workshop were Margaret Johnson, the Youth Engagement Strategist and Antara Buzarbaruah, who works in the learning and documentation team of the organization. The objective of the workshop was to create a safe space for the students to freely express the problems they face either in family, educational institutions or public places.

The resource persons started the session by briefly introducing themselves and the organization. After that there was an icebreaking session where the students were actively involved in various fun activities to break the hesitation and freely interact with the facilitators. Each student was given a sheet of paper with questions in it so as to assess their opinions on certain questions and reasoning skill.

After a short break, the 2nd session of the day started with a refreshing activity after which, there was an interactive discussion between the facilitator and the students on various topics like Gender, Safety, Respect, Trust, Gender-based violence and its causes and so on. The students gave their opinions about each topic and actively took part in the discussion. The facilitator then, initiated another activity called Columbian Hypnosis i.e. understanding the role of power play which taught the students how to break the dominant power and equally divide it.

The workshop ended with positive feedbacks from the students and words of appreciation by the resource people and the faculty. A total of 83 students attended the workshop and actively participated in it. The workshop was indeed a learning experience, and definitely a safe space for the students.

Students presented their skills by making a variety of 3D models, projects, collages, and paper art, among other things.

Prof. (Dr.) P. G. Ramesh, Dean, School of Engineering and Technology, The Assam Kaziranga University, began the competition with a welcome remark. First and foremost, he welcomed Chief Guest Shri. Tridip Jyoti Bhuyan, Additional Chief Engineer (i/c), Irrigation Department, Government of Assam, as well as all the participants and faculty members of the Assam Kaziranga University's School of Engineering and Technology. He spoke about the importance of civil engineers in his address.

Shri. Tridip Jyoti Bhuyan is currently employed at the Government of Assam's Irrigation Department as an Additional Chief Engineer (i/c). He studied civil engineering at Assam Engineering College and has worked in the sectors of irrigation and water resources for over thirty years. He reviewed the issues surrounding the Brahmaputra River and its tributaries and proposed a few remedies, including proper water usage for irrigation and other reasons, as well as the construction of proper water conveyance infrastructure with minimal losses. He also urged kids to pursue education in this field because of the numerous chances it provides. It is possible to dredge the Brahmaputra River. Remote sensing is being used to measure the Brahmaputra's discharge.




Artificial Neural Networks Application – Tractor Engine Performance

- The tractor is the major energy consumer in form of diesel at the farm. The most popular tractor is found in 31-40 hp segment, which accounts for about 45% of the total sales in the country (ICAR Data Book 2018).
- Presently the annual production of tractor is more than 7,90,673 units and power tiller is also crossed over 60,000 units per year. There are more than 24 tractor manufacturers in India at present (ICAR Data Book 2018).
- Depending on the type of fuel and the amount of time a tractor or machine is used, fuel and lubricant costs will usually represent at least 16% to over 45% of the total machine costs.

Webinar on “Life Skills Education for Career Development Organised by the School of Social Sciences

The School of Social Sciences of Assam Kaziranga University, Jorhat organized a Webinar “Life Skills Education for Career Development” in association with Institution Innovation Council (ICC) on 26th April 2022. The key speaker for the webinar was Ms. Veena Suresh, Asst. Professor, Department of Social Work in Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham, Kerala.

The webinar started with a Welcome Address by Harikrishnan U, Assistant Professor of the School of Social Sciences where he warmly welcomed the Speaker, the Dean, the faculties, and all the students who joined the webinar. It was then followed by a Special Speech by the Dean of the School of Social Sciences Prof. Dr. Chandra Kanta Gogoi. He spoke on how proper Education was necessary to find solutions to different problems in society. He also stated that Education should have practical implications to help others because without doing so, the knowledge that we gain becomes unproductive. Lastly, He stated that through Education one can develop certain valuable skills which can be beneficial and effective in solving the problems of society.

Following that, the speaker talked about how acquiring life skills can develop and help us grow personally and professionally. She also talked about the Strategies to Manage Stress and Emotions in difficult situations as it can affect one’s professional life and also the process of developing a career. Because when Stress and Emotions get the best of us there will not be any room for critical or creative thinking. An individual must learn how to critically look at an issue or a situation and be smart enough to be innovative and explore new ideas. The speaker also suggested the students not make any decisions under the influence of other people’s opinions or get carried away from others’ statements. The speaker also said that one needs to be empathetic instead of being apathetic or sympathetic if he/she wants to sustain a professional life for a long time. Lastly, the speaker suggested the students highlight the skills we acquired

Awareness programme on Prevention & Management of COVID-19 cum Health Camp & Vaccination Drive organized by School of Social Sciences in collaboration with Solmara Block PHC and Puranimati PHC of Jorhat district of Assam

The School of Social Sciences, Assam Kaziranga University as a part of its outreach activity conducted a day long awareness programme on Prevention & Management of COVID-19 cum COVID Vaccination drive in collaboration with the Solmara Block PHC and Puranimati PHC of Jorhat district of Assam. Webinar on “Skill Training in Psychosocial Rehabilitation for Social Workers”

The School of Social Sciences from the Assam Kaziranga University in association with the Institution’s Innovation Council (IIC) organized a webinar on “Skill training in psychosocial rehabilitation for social workers” on 30th April 2022 from 3 to 5 pm. The guest speaker was Dr. Sreekanth T who is a research fellow in a UK funded Project in the department of Psychiatry at National Institute of Mental Health and Neuroscience (NIMHANS), Bangalore.

The program started with welcome address by Mr. Harikrishnan U, Assistant Professor, Department of Social Work, School of Social Sciences, Assam Kaziranga University. The inaugural address was given by Dr. Srihari Krishna, Registrar, Assam Kaziranga University. It was followed by a speech by Prof. (Dr.) Chandra Kanta Gogoi, Dean of the School of Social Sciences, Assam Kaziranga University.

In his talk, Dr. Sreekanth T talked about the importance of the Biopsychosocial Model approach by George Engel in Psychosocial Rehabilitation and how all the factors are interconnected and important in assessing a person. He also talked about the role of the Psychiatric Social Worker in Psychosocial rehabilitation for the clinical intervention i.e., a clinical interview with the patient to assess the person’s severity of the symptoms and the problems, analyze and formulate the symptoms through a multi-factorial approach by keeping in mind all the biological, psychological and social factors (Bio-Psychosocial Model), assessing the vocational training for people with mental illness, networking between various governmental, non-governmental and religious organization for various disability welfare benefits, family tracing for the homeless mentally ill persons, etc.

Further, the speaker discussed two case studies with the participants and asked them to identify the psychosocial problems of the person and also to conduct a disability assessment scale where the participants actively performed the tasks. Dr. Sreekanth also discussed the different traditional models of rehabilitation i.e., the medical model which focused on the medical intervention for treatment, social model which thinks that disability is a socially created problem, recovery model believes that a person who grows beyond the catastrophic effects of the illness develops new meaning and purpose in one’s life and lastly the biopsychosocial model which integrates medical and social model as well as psychological model.

The speaker also shared the different scales for the assessment of disability (WHODAS and IDEAS), the assessment of social skills (Social skills assessment Proforma), the assessment of vocational potential (Vocational potential assessment scale), the assessment of recovery (Recovery assessment scale or recovery star) and lastly for the assessment of functionality (The global assessment of functioning).

After this, there was a Q&A session where the students put forward their queries and also their feedback on the webinar. The webinar ended with a vote of thanks by Ms. Lolly Lolly H Yeptho, 4th semester MSW student and student coordinator of the webinar, Department of Social Work, School of Social Sciences, Assam Kaziranga University. A total of 75 students attended the webinar which ended successfully.




